



### IT IS 100 SECONDS TO MIDNIGHT

The Doomsday Clock remains at 100 seconds to Midnight <https://thebulletin.org/>

While inflation and food shortages threaten the lives and livelihoods of billions around the globe, while the COVID-19 pandemic continues, while the US urges elongating the war between the Ukraine and Russia and underwrites other wars in Yemen, Syria, Somalia, Iraq – the urgent existential crises of the nuclear war threat and climate scorching continue a deadly trajectory.

To the good, the new Biden administration extended the New START arms control agreement with Russia, but at the same time moved conventional and nuclear forces up to the Russian border. It rejoined the JCPOA nuclear negotiations with Iran, although with little progress.

It rejoined the Paris Climate Accords, yet proposes new oil and gas drilling permits, continuing fracking and pipeline development.

It continues the \$1.7 trillion development of new nuclear weapons generating another nuclear arms race. And it proposes over \$800 billion in new military spending for 2023, half the federal discretionary budget.
